# 2022, a new impetus

Dear Donors, dear Friends,

2022 was a landmark year for ESCP Business School and its Foundation, which celebrated its 10th anniversary as a registered charitable foundation.

ESCP was placed for the first time among the Top 3 business schools in Europe in the Financial Times business school rankings - the global reference - a tribute to its pan-European development strategy and an achievement that will reinforce its societal impact and international appeal.

This success is also yours, since through your donations, you help to support the reach and standing of your School. Your generosity increased by 68%, to reach a total of almost €5M received in donations for the first time at the end of 2022. In addition, donations of €5.4M have been promised for the coming years, allowing us to plan the aid we can provide to the School over a longer period. A VERY big thank you for that!

Almost ten ESCP Alumni and Friends have committed to make donations of €500K and €1M, following the example set by Francis Charles Lang-Amiot in 2019. We thank them most sincerely as such gifts allow new strategic projects to be launched or reinforced, in particular to boost equal opportunities, entrepreneurship or impact-based research.

The entire Foundation team and its Board of Directors also wish to express their warmest thanks to Christian Mouillon for his two terms served as President and to welcome Jean-Stéphane Arcis, who took up his new duties as President of the Foundation at the end of December 2022.

I wish to lead the Foundation to the next level, working in close coordination with the ESCP Alumni Association and its President Bertrand Dumazy (94).





In 2012, the ESCP Foundation became a French registered charitable foundation when it was granted "Fondation Reconnue d'Utilité Publique" (FRUP) status. In 2022, the 10th anniversary of that event was celebrated by a large number of you. A convivial, friendly event in the sumptuous setting of the Philanthro-Lab brought together people from every part of the wider ESCP community: donors of all generations, friends, corporate partners, scholarship students, members of student associations, representatives of the School, the Alumni association and the Foundation. A huge thank you to all of them! The power of a School like ours is also that of the donors that support us.

### Piano concerts



For this second edition of the students' end-of-year concert, sponsored by the Foundation, our Patrons and Major Donors were invited to come and listen to young talents performing on the School's Bösendorfer concert piano, which was restored in 2021 thanks to their generosity. ## CEO Circle

### Creation of an ESCP Circle "The Inspiring CEO"



The Foundation and the Alumni association have launched a new Circle, "The Inspiring CEO", with the aim of bringing together the major emblematic business leaders in the ESCP community, who represent a true source of inspiration for the young generations. The Circle offers an opportunity to reconnect with the School, to meet with peers and play a part in the destiny of ESCP, for example by joining the Paris Campus Advisory Board. In practice, the Circle meets twice a year, in different formats and places, and also includes non-French speaking CEOs based all over the world.

### Two annual events



The Circle's inaugural dinner was held in **May** at the **Cercle de l'Union Interalliée** and featured a presentation of the new ESCP strategic campaign for 2022-2025: "Choice & Experiences". The second dinner took place in **December** at the home of a fantastic hostess, **Mrs Véronique Morali (83)** whom we thank most warmly. The Presidents of the ESCP Alumni Association and the Foundation made a joint speech on their shared challenge: to achieve a stronger mobilisation of the Alumni community.

## Asset management

### Foundation workshops



The Foundation ran several cycles of workshops to raise awareness of the possibilities for philanthropic and tax optimisation. Two firms founded by Alumni, Magdae and Culture Patrimoine, shared their operational expertise on subjects as varied as financial freedom, holding companies or how to plan for a smooth wealth transfer. The wealth transfer workshops were co-organised with the ESCP Alumni Association's Active Seniors group. The workshops, some held in person while others were organised as webinars, were attended by some 200 participants between February and December.

# Support for Equal Opportunities and Inclusion

For over 10 years, the ESCP Foundation has been putting all its efforts into attracting the best talents and reducing inequalities between students. It helps to facilitate their studies, their daily lives and their integration by awarding life and emergency grants and study scholarships or acting as their guarantor for bank loans. The Foundation also supports a scheme to accompany Preparatory class pupils receiving grants in order to increase the social and geographical diversity of the student intake. In 2022, ESCP and its Foundation allocated a budget of €8m to the School's social diversity and inclusion policy.

## The projects supported

### Pre-admission

**Chances Augmentées** | This programme is aimed at students at the end of their first year of Preparatory class receiving level 4 to 7 grants and wishing to apply for one of the "Parisiennes" schools via the BCE (Banque Commune d'Épreuves) entrance exam. They are invited to spend two days at ESCP to help them prepare as well as possible for the ESCP Business School individual interview and modern language oral. They receive individual and group coaching to boost their confidence and help them make the best impression in their interviews. The ESCP Foundation covers the costs of these two days, refunding train tickets (from any address in Metropolitan France) and organising accommodation with volunteer students.

After a successful first edition that won participants' universal approval in 2021, ESCP decided to repeat the experience, and the School was delighted to host 50 selected applicants. Participants had the opportunity to hear talks from scholarship students and particularly appreciated being able to meet members of the community.

**Talent Spring** | 10 high-potential students with difficult personal circumstances benefited from this original access route to the MIM entrance exam. This programme is supported by the KPMG and ORPEA Foundations.



### Post-admission: financial assistance and mentoring

**ARTICLE 1** | Every year about ten ESCP students benefit from the mentoring scheme run by the Article 1 association, as well as activities such as visits to companies. Article 1 enables students to build a network in a kind, friendly setting outside the School. They can also get help with finding placements or companies providing internships.

**Social scholarships** | The ESCP Foundation sponsors the School's social scholarships scheme, its contributions varying according to funds raised. In 2022, the school doubled its budget due to an increase in numbers of students and scholarship applications. ESCP is aiming for 20% scholarship students on the Grande École programme by 2025-2026.

**Emergency fund** | A budget of €30,000 was allocated from the Foundation's emergency fund in 2022 to help some ten students faced with financial difficulties due to unforeseen circumstances (illness, job loss, other difficult situations, etc.). Aid is granted on a case-by-case basis in the form of exceptional grants allocated by the Foundation's Equal Opportunities & Inclusion committee.

**Solidarity Fund** | In 2022 €30,000 from the solidarity fund helped about ten students experiencing financial difficulties as a result of a systemic crisis (Covid-19, war in Ukraine, crisis in Lebanon, etc.). Aid is granted on a case-by-case basis in the form of exceptional grants allocated by the Foundation's Equal Opportunities & Inclusion committee.

**Guarantee fund** | The Foundation acts as guarantor for bank loans for academically excellent students who cannot be supported in this way by their families. The "risk" envelope guaranteed by the Foundation since the scheme began amounts to €439,000. It has helped 51 students, 27 of them in 2022.

## Annual welcome ceremony for new beneficiaries

Every autumn, the ESCP Foundation organises a welcome ceremony for the beneficiaries of the ESCP Equal Opportunities and Inclusion initiative. The 2022 edition was attended by almost 200 scholarship students on the Talent Spring and Chances Augmentées schemes or who had benefited from one of the Foundation's bank guarantees. The ceremony, which was followed by a convivial cocktail reception, was an opportunity for the Foundation to raise the students' awareness of the solidarity schemes implemented by the School and the Foundation. It is very often on this occasion that they realise that their studies have been made possible partly by the generosity of donors who are mainly Alumni. The highlight of the evening was the symbolic handing over of an €8m cheque immortalised by a fine photograph.

The Student Experience is at the heart of ESCP Business School's strategic plan for 2022-2025: Choice & Experiences. In 2022 the School created a new position, "Dean for Student Experience", and appointed Francesco Rattalino, until then Dean of the Turin campus, to implement innovative transformations on the six campuses. The Foundation has decided to make it one of its missions to support these initiatives to constantly improve the student experience. It was able to start its strategic thinking thanks to the decision of Christine (87) and Patrice (86) Louvet, to donate €500K to support this specific area. They have both become Patrons of the ESCP Foundation and we thank them sincerely.

## Focus on the flagship projects and ambitions

Thanks to Christine and Patrice's commitment as Patrons at the end of 2022, the Foundation helped to identify the strategic projects that it would support in the short and medium term, with the aim of improving and harmonising the experience students have on the different campuses and reinforcing their feeling of belonging.

# Support for Entrepreneurship

**Entrepreneurship is also at the heart of ESCP Business School's strategy, as the aim for the School is to become THE leading European business school for Entrepreneurship. It is therefore one of the four pillars the Foundation supports, and in 2022 it has received its first €1m major donation, specifically earmarked for the development of the European dimension of the Blue Factory, the school's incubator.**

## Entrepreneurship at ESCP Business School is about:

### High Impact Teaching

- on all the programmes, with over 20,000 people trained in 15 years
- 120 businesses created as part of the "Entrepreneurship and Innovation" specialised master's programme
- Option E (Entrepreneurship) of the MiM (Master in Management) programme is available on all campuses

### Research

- dozens of lecturers on all campuses
- 600 start-ups have benefited from ESCP's expertise
- 100 entrepreneurial projects with a turnover of over €100K and 20 projects with a turnover of over €100M
- one incubator, the Blue Factory

## Focus on the Blue Factory



The Blue Factory is ESCP's incubator set up in 2013. Its role is to support student entrepreneurs and ESCP Business School alumni, as well as the School's partners, at every stage in their entrepreneurial journey, whatever their line of business.

The support provided by the Blue Factory is based on 3 programmes:

- **START** (from the idea to the prototype): to mature the idea, test it and get a grasp of the future issues relating to the business creation. 160 future entrepreneurs per year, from all the programmes, 50% from the Paris campus and 10% from the other campuses and abroad;
- **SEED** (initial sales): to launch the business alongside other teams selected for a one-year programme. 10 projects a year in Paris and 2 projects a year in Berlin;
- **SCALE** (growth): to develop with the international community of ESCP entrepreneurs, a community of over 300 businesses.



## €1M to develop the Incubator Europe-wide

In 2022 the Foundation received an exceptional €1M donation from entrepreneur Nicolas Motelay (87), earning him Major Patron status. This donation is contributing to the opening of a new chapter for the Blue Factory: its European deployment from 2023 onwards. This will mainly involve recruiting and training coordinator-support workers on each of the campuses and opening of local co-working spaces. The objective is, within the next five years, to allow students and Alumni to launch and grow their projects faster and more easily, in Europe and internationally.

# Support for **Excellence in Academic Research and Innovation in Teaching**

**The ESCP Foundation actively supports the School's Research and Teaching activities. It does so in particular by funding Chairs and Professorships.**

**These Chairs and Professorships are a special way of involving corporate partners - companies, organisations or institutions - in supporting the School, and with the researchers they support on all campuses, they play an important role in innovation and stimulation at ESCP Business School.**

## Focus on the **Responsible Innovation in Africa Chair** supported by the **AXIAN** group

**In 2022, the Foundation worked on the launch of a new teaching and research Chair entitled "Responsible Innovation in Africa".**

Its mission is to contribute to the transformation of Africa for a sustainable future and to the development of the human capital necessary to the social and ecological transition.

Hassanein Hiridjee (97), CEO of the pan-African Axian group, has chosen ESCP to make a 5-year commitment to support a new Research and Teaching project. More than a conventional academic Chair, this initiative will focus on Equal Opportunities and aims to attract African students to the courses provided by the Chair, but also in the long run to help African high school pupils to gain admission to ESCP.

### **Objectives of the Chair**

- To open a specialised option in the Masters 2 year of the Grande École programme, to train ESCP students and young African talents together;
- To help companies and students to develop great career opportunities in Africa;
- To provide subjects for research projects and encourage cross-fertilisation of expertise on responsible innovation in Africa;
- To support African students so that they can take part in this option through a system of grants funded by the Foundation.

## TAX BREAKS IN FRANCE

### Individual donors

**66%** of your donation is deductible from your income tax, up to a ceiling of 20% of your net taxable income or **75%** of the donation can be deducted from your IFI (formerly the ISF wealth tax) up to a maximum annual donation of €66,667.

### Companies

**60%** of the donation is deductible from corporation tax up to a ceiling of 5‰ of the turnover or €20,000 for small and very small enterprises reaching this ceiling.

Note that for donations over €2M, the tax reduction is 40% for the portion over €2M.
